46th Annual NSRA Street Rod Nationals North Returns to Kalamazoo with Nearly 1,200 Pre-1996 Specialty Vehicles

Kalamazoo's largest automotive event features street rods, customs, muscle cars, trade show, family activities, and more than \$61,000 in prizes for participants!

KALAMAZOO, Mich. — The National Street Rod Association (NSRA) will present the 46th Annual Street Rod Nationals North on Friday and Saturday, September 25–26, 2026, at the Kalamazoo County Expo Center in Kalamazoo, Michigan. Recognized as the area's largest automotive event, the weekend is expected to draw close to 1,000 pre-1996 specialty vehicles from across the north-central United States and Canada.

Street rods, cool customs, pickups, muscle cars, pro-touring machines, will be on public display throughout the event, showcasing the enduring popularity of the specialty vehicle hobby.

In addition to the impressive vehicle lineup, attendees can enjoy a full slate of attractions, including an arts-and-crafts show, a slot car drag racing demonstration, the MHRA rod repair shop, kids' games and a coloring contest, a vintage automotive parts swap meet, Nick Donovan's Rockin' Road Show, and a live band preceding the awards program.

The NSRA's Super Prize Program will award more than \$61,000 in merchandise throughout the weekend. Three separate drawings for \$2,000 each will also take place—one on Friday for pre-registered participants and two during the awards program. All registered participants of the 2026 Street Rod Nationals North are eligible for the prizes.

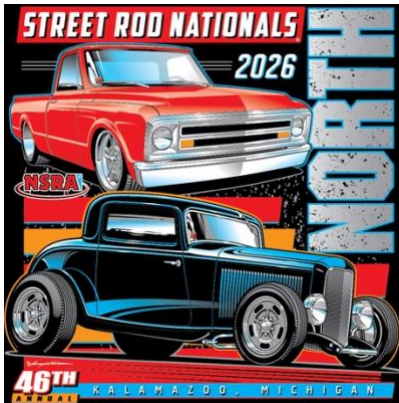
Special displays will highlight Star Customs GR, this year's Spotlight Builder, with vehicles on display outside both days.

On Saturday, September 26, the popular Streets of Rods will take place, followed by the "Circle of Winners" showcase featuring all award-winning vehicles. The awards ceremony is scheduled for 5:00 p.m. Saturday.

Inside the spacious exhibit hall, dozens of manufacturers and dealers of specialty automotive equipment will display and sell products, accessories, and supplies. A dedicated arts & craft's area will feature assorted arts, crafts, from regional artists.

All activities are open to the public. Spectator hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Admission is \$20 for ages 13 and older, \$6 for children ages 6–12, and free for children 5 and under when accompanied by an adult. A family pass (two adults and three children 12 and under) is available for \$45. Active military personnel, seniors over 60, and NSRA members receive a \$2.00 discount with proper identification (one discounted admission per person).
